WHAT IS THE PRAGUE COFFEE FESTIVAL?

Prague Coffee Festival is based on the idea of supporting the Czech coffee culture and enabling all those who are interested in coffee to meet each other - regardless if they are the baristas, coffeeshop owners, coffee beginners and those who are already familiar with coffee, but are still eager to know more. Prague Coffee Festival tries to put the coffee-related topics in the program in a broader context, so that everyone would come into his own. The participants can enjoy the lectu-res, coffee tasting of the samples from local and foreign roasteries, presentation of coffeeshops and individual baristas, workshops of the alternative coffee preparation methods, and also the competitions and additional program.





WHO ORGANIZES THE PRAGUE COFFEE FESTIVAL?

Prague Coffee Festival 2016 is organized by NGO Coffee Embassy whose main goal is to promote coffee culture and introduce the topics referring to coffee, its growers, processors and new methods in the industry to the general public. The activities of the Coffee Embassy include organization the educational courses about coffee or public cuppings, creation of an independent platform for baristas, organization of the biggest annual Czech coffee event - the Prague Coffee Festival - or cooperation with development projects in the coffee producing countries.





PRAGUE COFFEE FESTIVAL 2016

The fifth Prague Coffee Festival took place this year and the visitors could enjoy two days full of coffee sensation in the unique Franz Kafka's House in the heart of Prague. It was possible to taste the coffee from Czech and foreign roasteries at the espresso bars, brew bars, and in the cuppings.

The lectures were aimed at both professional and non-professional public and the guests could learn among other things how to start a successful coffee business by British barista Gwilym Davies, or about specialty coffee in capsules by world-famous expert Maxwell Colonna-Dashwood. Aside from the Czech and foreign experts and baristas, the farmers from the coffee plantations from Nicaragua and Brazil also took part in the lectures.

There were workshops and contests not only in traditional and alternative coffee preparation methods, but also for example in latte art - painting in the coffee with milk - or art workshop with coffee cups.

At the occasion of Prague Coffee Festival, the fourth edition of the special coffeeshop guide in the Czech republic was published - the Book of Cafés 2016.

The whole event was perfected by the music by DJ Pocoloco from Cabaret Manana and MC Ondra.

Live Vanilla Choice band performed later at the traditional afterparty in Café Jedna.
